A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 26, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows: 3 4 "§26- Lieutenant governor special fund. (a) There is 5 established in the state treasury the lieutenant governor 6 special fund, into which shall be deposited all revenues from name change fees, apostille and certification fees, and copy 7 8 fees. 9 (b) Moneys in the lieutenant governor special fund shall be used for the administration and operation of the functions of 10 the lieutenant governor as provided in section 26-1(a)." 11 SECTION 2. Chapter 92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 12 13 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to 14 read as follows: 15 "§92-Lieutenant governor; fees. The lieutenant governor shall charge the following fees which shall be 16 17 deposited to the lieutenant governor special fund: For signing an apostille or certification, \$10; 18 (1)

8	SECTION 3	. Section 91-2.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
9	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$80,000 or so much 4 5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012, to carry out the purposes of this Act, including the hiring of necessary 6 7 staff. The sum appropriated shall be deposited into the 8 Lieutenant Governor Special Fund and shall expended by the office of the lieutenant governor. 9 10 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the Lieutenant Governor Special Fund the sum of \$80,000 or so much thereof as 11 12 may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 to carry out the purposes of this Act, including the hiring of necessary staff. 13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of the 14 15 lieutenant governor. This Act shall take effect SECTION 6.

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 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 7, 2011.

- PURPOSE: Establishes the Lieutenant Governor special fund in the lieutenant governor's office, and provides that all revenue from name changes, apostille and certification fees, and copy fees be deposited into the fund.
- MEANS: Adds news sections to chapters 26 and 92 and amend section 91.2-5(a), Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- JUSTIFICATION: The creation of the special fund will ensure that the individuals that benefit from the services provided to them by the lieutenant governor's office will pay for the cost of providing the service.

Impact on the public: The bill ensures that the general public will not subsidize the cost of providing services for name changes, apostilles and certifications, or for copy fees.
