RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
 the Hawaii Constitution.

4 SECTION 2. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate state 5 funds and matching federal medicaid funds to address a funding 6 shortfall in the medicaid program. The combined state and 7 federal funding will help to provide continuing health care in 8 our communities.

9 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011 for
12 health care payments (HMS 401) to address a funding shortfall in
13 the medicaid program.

SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of federal medicaid funds the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011 for health care payments (HMS 401) as a federal match for state funds.

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SECTION 5. The sums appropriated shall be expended by the
 department of human services for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
