BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 711, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	" §711- Animal fighting; attendance prohibited. (a) It
5	shall be unlawful for any person to knowingly attend or pay to
6	attend an animal fight.
7	(b) Violation of this section shall be a petty
8	misdemeanor, and in addition to any other penalty a court may
9	impose, a person convicted under this section shall be sentenced
10	as follows, without possibility of suspension of sentence:
11	(1) For a first offense:
12	(A) A fine of \$500; provided that upon the
13	defendant's request, the court may grant
14	eighty hour of community service in lieu of
15	the fine;
16	(2) For a second offense:
17	(A) A fine of \$750; provided that upon the

1	hundred fifty hours of community service in
2	lieu of the fine; and
3	(3) For a third or subsequent offense:
4	(A) A fine of \$1,000; provided that upon the
5	defendant's request, t he court may grant

7	lieu of the fine.
8	(c) As used in this section:
9	"Animal fight" means the intentional fighting or baiting of
10	any bull, bear, cock, or other animal for amusement or gain.
11	"Knowingly attend" means anyone present within the
12	immediate vicinity of an exhibition of animal fighting or
13	preparations thereto who incites, gives patronage, encourages,
14	or urges others in the commission thereof."
15	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
16	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
17	begun before its effective date.
18	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
19	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
