Burns school of medicine special fund established under section 304A-2171 to 8 9 support ongoing assessment and planning of the physician 10 workforce in Hawaii [-]; provided that any 'excess funds from the 11 fund shall be used for: 12 (1) Assessing reimbursement reform;

- 13 (2) Expediting reimbursements to physicians;
- 14 (3) Educating physicians on the impact of federal health
- 15 care reform; and
- 16 (4) Advancing the medical home model.
- 17 Payment of the physician workforce assessment fee shall be

18 required for license renewal."
