A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PLANNING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that actions taken by
- 2 state agencies, though motivated by a desire to improve the
- 3 quality of life for our community, sometimes result in
- 4 unintended adverse effects. To minimize or prevent these
- 5 negative impacts, state agencies should consider community plans
- 6 already in place when planning future actions.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to require state agencies to
- 8 consider existing community plans when planning future actions
- 9 that may impact a specific community.
- 10 SECTION 2. Chapter 26, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 11 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 12 read as follows:
- 13 "§26- State agency action; community plans. (a)
- 14 During its planning process for, and prior to, action that will
- 15 impact a community, a state agency shall review all existing
- 16 community plans. The state agency shall consider the provisions
- **17** in each plan, make reasonable efforts to conform to the
- 18 provisions of each plan when possible, and report, in writing,

1 areas where its intended action will conflict with the 2 provisions of each plan. 3 (b) For the purposes of this section: 4 "Action" means the implementation of a program, project, or 5 initiative by a state agency. 6 "Community plan" means an existing plan, intended to 7 improve the quality of life within that community in some manner, which has been finalized and made publicly available, in 8 written or online form, on January 1, 2006, or thereafter, that 9 10 meets at least one of the following criteria: 11 (1) A plan developed by the community in partnership with 12 other government entities, including state agencies; 13 (2) A plan developed by the community in response to a 14 government request, including legislative resolutions; 15 or16 A plan developed by the neighborhood board or other (3) organization within the community. **17** 18 "State agency" means an office, division, department, or 19 instrumentality of the State." 20 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
