- 1 SECTION 1. Section 712-1240, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending the definition of "dangerous drugs" to read
- 3 as follows:
- 4 ""Dangerous drugs" means any substance or immediate
- 5 precursor defined or specified as a "Schedule I substance" or a
- 6 "Schedule II substance" by chapter 329, or a substance specified
- 7 in section 329-18(c)(13), except marijuana or marijuana
- 8 concentrate[-], and also includes mephedrone and
- 9 methylenedioxypyrovalerone, also known as MDPV."
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 11 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 12 begun before its effective date.
- 13 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
