BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2	by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3	read as follows:
4	" <u>§46-</u> Agricultural and aquacultural structures; no
5	building permit required. (a) Notwithstanding any law to the
6	contrary, no county shall require a building permit for the
7	construction of low risk nonresidential temporary or permanent
8	structures used for agricultural or aquacultural operations;
9	provided that:
10	(1) The tenant agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold
11	harmless, the State and any of its agencies, officers,
12	and employees, from and against all liability, loss,
13	damage, cost and expense, including attorneys' fees
14	and costs, and all claims, suits, and demands
15	therefore, arising out of or resulting from the
16	failure to obtain building permits, and waive any
17	statutory or other immunity from liability that may be
18	asserted by the tenant to limit the tenant's
