A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BUILDING PERMITS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended	
2	by adding	a new section to be appropriately designated and to	
3	read as follows:		
4	" <u>§46</u>	- Agricultural and aquacultural structures; no	
5	building	permit required. (a) Notwithstanding any law to the	
6	contrary,	no county shall require a building permit for the	
7	construction of low-risk nonresidential temporary or permanent		
8	structures used for agricultural or aquacultural operations;		
9	provided that:		
10	(1)	The owner or occupier agrees to defend, indemnify, and	
11		hold harmless the State and any of its agencies,	
12		officers, and employees from and against all	
13		liability, loss, damage, cost, and expense, including	
14		attorneys' fees and costs, and all claims, suits, and	
15		demands arising out of or resulting from the lack of	
16		building permits for any low-risk nonresidential	
17		structure, and waive any statutory or other immunity	
18		from liability that may be asserted by the owner or	
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. 1		occupier to limit the owner or occupier's obligation	
2		to so defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the State	
3		and any of its agencies, officers, and employees; and	
4	(2)	Any permanent structure constructed pursuant to this	
5		section shall be designed and engineered according to	
6		the version of the International Building Code that	
7		has been adopted by the respective county, as	
8		published by the International Code Council.	
9	(b)	As used in this section:	
10	"Agr	icultural" means relating to the raising of animals or	
11	the planting, cultivating, harvesting, and processing of crops,		
12	including those planted, cultivated, harvested, and processed		
13	for food,	ornamental, grazing, or forestry purposes.	
14	"Aqu	acultural" means relating to the propagation,	
15	cultivation, or farming of aquatic plants and animals in		
16	controlled or selected environments for research purposes,		
17	commercial purposes, or stocking purposes, including aquaponics		
18	or any growing of plants or animals with aquaculture effluents.		
19	"Low	-risk" means, of a structure, being one thousand five	
20	hundred square feet or smaller.		
21	"Temporary structure" means a building that is ancillary to		
22	the agric	ultural or aquacultural operation and is not designed	
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- 1 to remain permanently in place, including recycled ocean
- 2 shipping and cargo containers, modular structures, agricultural
- 3 cold frames, and storage sheds."
- 4 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
