H.B. NO. 1268

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the health benefits 2 plan for beneficiaries of the Hawaii employer-union health 3 benefits trust fund should be delivered in an integrated manner. 4 Offering medical benefits and prescription drug benefits to 5 beneficiaries through separate carriers results in a fragmented 6 health care delivery system that may result in higher costs and 7 reduced quality of care. The purpose of this Act is to 8 integrate medical benefits and prescription drug benefits that 9 are offered to beneficiaries of the Hawaii employer-union health 10 benefits trust fund.

11 SECTION 2. Section 87A-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 12 amended to read as follows: .

13 "[+]\$87A-16[+] Health benefits plan; carriers. (a) The
14 board shall establish the health benefits plan or plans, which
15 shall be exempt from the minimum group requirements of chapter
16 431.

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1 (b) The board may contract for health benefits plans or provide health benefits through a noninsured schedule of 2 3 benefits.

4 (c) To the extent the board contracts for health benefits 5 plans, it shall enter into contracts with carriers that provide 6 or administer prescription drug benefits together with medical 7 benefits."

8 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
