RELATING TO SMALL CLAIMS COURT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 633-27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 "(a) All district courts, except as otherwise provided, 4 shall exercise jurisdiction conferred by this chapter, and while sitting in the exercise of that jurisdiction, shall be known and 5 6 referred to as the small claims division of the district court; 7 provided that the jurisdiction of the court when sitting as a small claims division of the district court shall be confined 8 9 to: 10 (1) Cases for the recovery of money only where the amount 11 claimed does not exceed [\$3,500] \$4,500, exclusive of 12 interest and costs, except as provided by section 13 633-30; 14 (2) Cases involving disagreement between landlord and 15 tenant about the security deposit in a residential 16 landlord-tenant relationship; and

1	(3) Cases for the return of leased or rented personal
2	property worth $[\$3,500]$ $\$4,500$ or less where the
3	amount claimed owed for that lease or rental does not
4	exceed [$$3,500$] $$4,500$, exclusive of interest and
5	costs.
6	This chapter shall not abridge or affect the jurisdiction of the
7	district courts under paragraphs (1) and (3) to determine cases
8	under the ordinary procedures of the court, it being optional
9	with [the plaintiff] either party in the cases to elect the
10	procedure of the small claims division of the district court or
11	the ordinary procedures, as provided by rule of court. No case
12	filed in the small claims division after December 31, 1991,
13	shall be removed from the small claims division to be heard
14	under the ordinary procedures of the district court unless the
15	removal is agreed to by [the plaintiff.] either party. In cases
16	arising under paragraph (2) the jurisdiction of the small claims
17	division of the district court shall be exclusive; provided that
18	the district court, having jurisdiction over a civil action
19	involving summary possession, shall have concurrent jurisdiction
20	with the small claims division of the district court over any
21	security deposit dispute between landlord and tenant in a

- 1 residential landlord-tenant relationship. This subsection shall
- 2 not abrogate nor supersede sections 604-5, 633-30, and 633-31."
- 3 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
