1	SECTION 1. Chapter 145, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	" §145- Food safety certified farms. (a) Any person
5	engaged in the business of growing or producing any edible farm
6	produce shall be a food safety certified farm prior to joining
7	any agricultural organization within the State.
8	(b) As used in this section:
9	"Agricultural organization" means any association,
10	organization, or cooperative, whether for-profit or nonprofit,
11	that accepts membership from producers.
12	"Food safety certified farm" means a farm that has complied
13	with all requirements to receive a successful third party food
14	safety audit through the department."
15	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
16	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
