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A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that the University of SECTION 1. 2 Hawaii is accountable to the legislature and to the people of 3 the State of Hawaii for providing a public higher education 4 system designed to meet the needs of the citizens of the State, 5 and for using its funds in a manner that is consistent with its 6 goals and understandable to the legislature and to the public. 7 The legislature acknowledges that the University of Hawaii has 8 adopted strategic goals which are linked to performance outcomes 9 that are measurable and that indicate the extent to which the University of Hawaii and its campuses have achieved these goals. 10 11 Furthermore, the University of Hawaii has proposed an outcomes 12 funding model directly tied to strategic indicators.

13 The purpose of this Act is to, among other things:

14 (1) Repeal the current statutory provisions relating to
15 benchmark reporting in favor of higher education

2	pursuant to section 226-57 that includes strategic goals,

6	opportunities to become [an international] a foremost		
7	educational, research, and service center of learning to be

10	but not be limited to:		
11	(1)	Expanding access to educational opportunity throughout

13	(2)	Striving for excellence in undergraduate education;	
14	(3)	Requiring the university to continue to gain	
15		prominence in research and distance learning;	
16	(4)	Revitalizing services to the State;	
17	(5)	Enhancing the international role of the university;

19	(6)	Maintaining diversity by clarifying campus missions	
20		and coordinating campus plans.	

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1 The university shall periodically review its strategic (C) 2 goals and outcomes and the public higher education needs of the 3 State. 4 [(b)] (d) The board of regents shall apply [these 5 benchmarks] the university's functional plan, including 6 strategic goals and outcomes in the development of their 7 [annual] budget request to the legislature [and adoption of 8 tuition schedules 9 (c) The university shall conduct a periodic review of all 10 instruction, organized research, public service, academic 11 support, student services, and institutional support programs at 12 each campus to determine whether the programs are operating for the purposes originally established and not inconsistent with 13 14 the benchmarks adopted pursuant to subsection (a)]. 15 (e) The university shall submit a biennium report [of its 16 findings] on the functional plan, including strategic outcomes. 17 and performance measures to the legislature no later than twenty 18 days prior to the convening of the [legislature] regular 19 legislative session in the second year of each fiscal biennium." 20 SECTION 3.
