A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII TOBACCO SETTLEMENT SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the John A. Burns
- 2 school of medicine is authorized under existing statute to use a
- 3 portion of Hawaii tobacco settlement special fund moneys for
- 4 annual operating expenses to support the school's operations and
- 5 train and graduate new physicians. The legislature further
- 6 finds that if no action is taken, the school's authorization to
- 7 use those funds will expire on June 30, 2011.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to extend the authorization that
- 9 allocates a portion of Hawaii tobacco settlement special fund
- 10 moneys to the John A. Burns school of medicine for annual
- 11 operating expenses.
- 12 SECTION 2. Act 264, Session Laws of Hawaii 2007, as
- 13 amended by section 22 of Act 16, Session Laws of Hawaii 2008, is
- 14 amended by amending section 4 to read as follows:
- "SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007,
- and shall be repealed on June 30, [2011;] 2015; provided that
- 17 section 328L-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted in

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- 1 the form in which it read on the day before the effective date
- 2 of this Act."
- 3 SECTION 3. The University of Hawaii shall prepare a
- 4 detailed accounting of all revenues and expenditures relating
- 5 to:
- 6 (1) Moneys appropriated into the university revenue-
- 7 undertakings fund established under section
- **8** 304A-2167.5; and
- 9 (2) Any moneys used for the operating costs of the medical
- school facility.
- 11 This accounting information shall be submitted to the
- 12 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 13 the regular sessions of 2012, 2013, 2014, and 2015.
- 14 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 16 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
