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A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:		
SECTION 1. Chapter 328, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and		
to read as follows:		
"PART .		
HAND-POUNDED POI		
§328- Producer of hand-pounded poi; exemption;		
inspections. (a) An individual producer of hand-pounded poi		
shall not be required to prepare poi in a certified food-		
processing establishment or be required to obtain a permit from		
the department, if the producer:		
(1) Sells hand-pounded poi directly to consumers;		
(2) Attends a food-safety class approved by the		
department;		
(3) Abides by community best practices, as determined by		
subsection (c);		
(4) Maintains a working sink at the site the hand-pounded		
poi is produced; and		
(5) Labels each batch of hand-pounded poi with:		

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1	(A)	The name and address of the producer;	
2	(B)	The net weight of the hand-pounded poi, by	
3		standard measure;	
4	(C)	The date on which the hand-pounded poi was	
5		produced; and	
6	(D)	The following statement in clear and conspicuous	
7		print: "This hand-pounded taro product was not	
8		prepared in a Department of Health approved	
9		facility and may increase your risk of food borne	
10		illness."	
11	(b) If the department receives a consumer complaint about		
12	an individual producer of hand-pounded poi regarding the poi,		
13	the producer shall be immediately subject to food sampling and		
14	subsequent inspection of the producer's premises to determine if		
15	the producer's products are mislabeled or adulterated. If the		
16	department receives such complaints, especially complaints		
17	regarding food borne illness, the department is authorized to		
18	issue a cease and desist notice to terminate any distribution or		
19	sale of the poi in question; provided that the department shall		
20	conduct a hearing pursuant to chapter 91 prior to the issuance		
21	of the notice.		

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(c) The department shall adopt rules in accordance with 1 chapter 91 to carry out the purposes of this section, including 2 adopting a list of customary and traditional Hawaiian cultural 3 4 food-preparation practices. (d) As used in this section: 5 "Hand-pounded poi" means poi that is produced by hand using 6 customary and traditional Hawaiian cultural food-preparation 7 8 practices. "Hand-pounded" means processed with papa kui ai and pohaku 9 kui ai and without the use of machines or machinery. 10 "Pohaku kui ai" means a poi pounding stone. 11 "Papa kui ai" means a poi pounding board. 12 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050. 13
