## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. (a) The attorney general shall coordinate a
2	review of	the impact that diversion of drug possession offenders
3	into drug	treatment would have on the criminal justice system,
4	drug trea	tment program resources, and public safety. For
5	purposes	of this review:
6	(1)	"Diversion" means placement of the offender into drug
7		treatment in lieu of charging the offender or allowing
8		the offender to plead to a misdemeanor and be placed
9		in treatment in lieu of imprisonment; and
10	(2)	"Drug possession offenders" means those accused of
11		felony marijuana possession offenses of any grade and
12		class B or C felony possession offenses involving
13		other drugs.
14	(b)	The review required by subsection (a) shall address
15	the follo	wing issues;
16	(1)	The number of offenders that could be diverted if
17		diversion occurred before charging and the number that

could be deferred post-charging;
