A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC WORK PROJECTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that under current law, a 2 contractor found to be in violation of the prevailing wage law 3 under chapter 104, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is considered to 4 have committed only one violation although other violations may 5 be occurring or recurring simultaneously on multiple public work 6 projects performed by the same contractor. The purpose of this 7 Act is to ensure that a violation of chapter 104, Hawaii Revised 8 Statutes, arises with each separate project in which the 9 department of labor and industrial relations finds that a contractor has failed to comply with the law. 10 11 SECTION 2. Section 104-24, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 12 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows: 13 "(d) A first, second, or third violation refers to each

14 [investigation involving one or more projects] project in which 15 the department finds that a contractor has failed to comply with 16 this chapter."
