RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

7	requires minimal or no co-payments for smoking cessation by the		
8	following methods:		
9	(1) Telephone and individual counseling and intervention		
10	sessions;		
11	(2) Prescription coverage for nicotine replacement		
12	products and tobacco cessation medications approved by		
13	the United States Food and Drug Administration; and		
14	(3) Counseling and medication coverage for smoking		
15	cessation attempts.		
16	(b) Beginning March 1, 2012, policy information for every		
17	policy of accident and health or sickness insurance issued in

Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 14 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
