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### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	" <u>§</u> 34	6- Higher education scholarship program. (a)	
5	There sha	ll be established within the department of human	
6	services	a higher education scholarship program for eligible	
7	former for	ster youth. An eligible former foster youth shall be	
8	eligible for higher education scholarships after reaching the		
9	age of majority, and the higher education scholarships shall be		
10	awarded t	o that former foster youth; provided that:	
11	(1)	The former foster youth is twenty-six years old or	
12		younger; and	
13	(2)	The former foster youth is attending or has been	
14		accepted to attend an accredited institution of higher	
15		education.	
16	(b)	The higher education scholarship may be awarded while	
17	the forme	r foster youth is attending an accredited institution	



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1	of higher education on a full-time basis or on a part-time		
2	basis, in accordance with rules adopted by the department.		
3	(c) Higher education scholarships may be used by the		
4	former youth to pay for costs incurred in undertaking full-time		
5	studies or part-time studies at an institution of higher		
6	education in accordance with rules adopted by the department.		
7	(d) The department's standards relating to income		
8	resources of foster children shall be applicable to this		
9	section.		
10	(e) Higher education scholarships shall be provided		
11	subject to the availability of state and federal funds."		
12	SECTION 2. The Act establishes a higher education		
13	scholarship program for eligible former foster youth in lieu of		
14	the existing higher education board allowance program		
15	established under section 346-17.4, Hawaii Revised Statutes.		
16	The department of human services shall cease accepting new		
17	applications for higher education board allowances upon the		
18	effective date of this Act. The department shall submit a		
19	report to the legislature no later than twenty days before the		
20	regular session of 2012 that shall include:

higher education board allowances program;



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1	(2)	Any other issues relating to the anticipated
2		termination of the higher education board allowances
3		program and the implementation in lieu thereof of the
4		higher education scholarship program provided for in
5		this Act; and
6	(3)	The date by which the higher education board allowance
7		program can be terminated without prejudice to its
8		existing participants.
