A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE MOLOKAI IRRIGATION SYSTEM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that construction on the 2 Molokai irrigation system was started in 1957 to provide water 3 to the central farming areas of Molokai as part of a federal and 4 state commitment to native Hawaiian homesteaders, consistent 5 with the objectives of the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act, 1920, 6 as amended, to enable native Hawaiians to return to their lands 7 and promote self-sufficiency. The provision of adequate amounts 8 of water at a reasonable rate for agricultural operations on 9 Hawaiian home lands remains central to this policy.

10 The legislature further finds that the high cost of water 11 delivery is causing a hardship on Hawaiian homestead farmers, 12 making it difficult for some lessees to pay their water bill. 13 In the past, the state department of agriculture offered a 14 discounted rate to Molokai irrigation system water users. However, this discounted rate was eliminated in 2009 due to a 15 16 significant drop in water consumption and consequent reduction in revenues. 17

21	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general

thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 and the
sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for
fiscal year 2012-2013 to cover the operational costs of the
Molokai irrigation system.

5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of6 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.

7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
