## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE MOLOKAI IRRIGATION SYSTEM.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that construction on the
  Molokai irrigation system was started in 1957 to provide water
  to the central farming areas of Molokai as part of a federal and
  state commitment to native Hawaiian homesteaders, consistent
  with the objectives of the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act, 1920,
- 6 as amended, to enable native Hawaiians to return to their lands
- 7 and promote self-sufficiency. The provision of adequate amounts
- 8 of water at a reasonable rate for agricultural operations on
- 9 Hawaiian home lands remains central to this policy.
- 10 The legislature further finds that the high cost of water
- 11 delivery is causing a hardship on Hawaiian homestead farmers,
- 12 making it difficult for some lessees to pay their water bills.
- 13 In the past, the department of agriculture offered a discounted
- 14 rate to Molokai irrigation system water users. However, this
- 15 discounted rate was eliminated in 2009 due to a significant drop
- 16 in water consumption and consequent reduction in revenues.
- 17 The purpose of this Act is to carry out the objectives of
- 18 the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act, 1920, as amended, by:



1	(1)	Providing water to Molokai irrigation system water

9	SECTION 2. (a) The department of agriculture shall	
10	provide water to Molokai irrigation system users who lease

12	Homes Com	mission Act, 1920, as amended, at a reduced rate of at
13	least	per cent but not more than per cent of the
14	standard:	rate from July 1, 2011, to June 30, 2013.
15	(d)	The department of agriculture shall forgive all
16	amounts o	wed by any Molokai homestead farmer for the provision
17	of irriga	tion water that are past due as of the effective date

19	SECT	ION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
20	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much	
21	thereof as	s may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 and the

- 1 fiscal year 2012-2013 to cover the operational costs of the
- 2 Molokai irrigation system.
- 3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 4 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.

## Description:

Requires the Department of Agriculture to provide water to Molokai irrigation system users who lease tracts of land under section 207 of the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act, 1920, as amended, at a reduced rate. Requires the Department of Agriculture to forgive past due amounts owed by Molokai homestead farmers for irrigation water. Appropriates funds to cover the operational costs of the Molokai irrigation system. Effective July 1, 2030. (HB1483 HD1)
