BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 200, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	" <u>\$200-</u> <u>Commercial excursions; permit conditions.</u> Any
5	person or entity who, in the course of providing an excursion
6	using boating facilities within the State, disembarks fare-
7	paying passengers in a county with a population of two hundred
8	thousand or less with the expectation that the passengers will
9	visit and participate in recreational activity on state property
10	adjacent to quasi-public property before the conclusion of the
11	excursion, shall ensure that all passengers while ashore are
12	accompanied by and remain at all times during the excursion
13	under the active supervision and direction of a member of the
14	crew qualified to render emergency care.
15	As used in this section, "quasi-public property" means a
16	beach park transferred from a private entity to a county in
17	perpetuity for park and recreational purposes, which may be
