### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that homelessness has
 been increasing rapidly in Hawaii and that the State has opened
 several new shelters. In spite of efforts by government and
 nonprofit organizations to provide overnight shelter to homeless
 persons, there are still many homeless individuals who sleep in
 public parks, along sidewalks, and other areas.

7 The legislature further finds that native Hawaiians 8 constitute a substantial percentage of the homeless population 9 in Hawaii. In fact, nearly forty per cent of the homeless 10 population is native Hawaiian. Many of these individuals choose 11 not to use homeless shelters because their lifestyles conflict 12 with shelter rules.

13 The purpose of this Act is to address the disproportionate 14 number of native Hawaiians among the State's homeless by 15 requiring the office of Hawaiian affairs to develop a pilot 16 program to establish kanaka villages for homeless native 17 Hawaiians.

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1 SECTION 2. (a) Notwithstanding any other law to the 2 contrary, the office of Hawaiian affairs shall develop and 3 implement a pilot program to establish kanaka villages on every island for native Hawaiians who are homeless. The office of 4 Hawaiian affairs shall: 5 6 (1) Collaborate with the department of Hawaiian home lands 7 and the Hawaii public housing authority to develop and 8 implement the program; 9 (2)Designate areas in the State on which to establish the 10 kanaka villages; and 11 Establish kanaka villages on Hawaiian home lands. (3) 12 (b) For the purposes of this Act, "kanaka villages" mean 13 communities where native Hawaiians who are homeless may live in 14 tents and subsist off the land using traditional Hawaiian 15 methods of sustainability. 16 SECTION 3. The office of Hawaiian affairs, in consultation 17 with the department of Hawaiian home lands and the Hawaii public 18 housing authority, shall report to the legislature, no later 19 than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session 20 of 2012, on actions taken on the pilot program. The report

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- shall include any pertinent information, recommendations, and
  necessary proposed legislation.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.



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#### Report Title:
