## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHWAY SAFETY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 291, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§291- Towing safety apparatus. (a) No operator of a
- 5 motor vehicle shall tow on any highway any trailer, semitrailer,
- 6 or pole trailer, or any combination thereof, unless the trailer,
- 7 semitrailer, or pole trailer, or any combination thereof, is
- 8 secured by a towing safety apparatus to the motor vehicle that
- 9 is towing the trailer, semitrailer, or pole trailer, or any
- 10 combination thereof.
- 11 (b) This section shall be enforceable by police officers
- 12 who may issue a summons or citation to the operator for the
- 13 violation. An operator who violates this section shall be fined
- 14 not less than \$100 and not more than \$500 for each separate
- 15 violation.
- 16 (c) Evidence that a trailer, semitrailer, or pole trailer,
- 17 or any combination thereof, breaks away from a motor vehicle
- that is towing the trailer, semitrailer, or pole trailer, or any



- 1 combination thereof, shall be prima facie evidence of a
- 2 violation of this section.
- 3 (d) For purposes of this section, "towing safety
- 4 apparatus" means a trailer receiver hitch connected to a ball
- 5 mount or draw bar which is secured with a locking pin and chains
- 6 or cables to keep the trailer, semitrailer, pole trailer, or any
- 7 combination thereof, safely connected to the motor vehicle if
- 8 the trailer, semitrailer, pole trailer, or any combination
- 9 thereof becomes unhitched from the ball mount or draw bar while
- 10 being towed.
- 11 (e) This section shall not apply to towing companies or
- 12 motor carriers as defined under section 286-201."
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 14 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 15 begun before its effective date.
- 16 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
