### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 514B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part VI to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§514B-</u> <u>Adoption of rules; prohibition of smoking.</u>
5	Unless otherwise prohibited by the articles of incorporation or
6	bylaws, an association:
7	(1) May adopt bylaws or rules to prohibit unit owners,
8	guests, and all other persons from smoking within
9	dwelling units in the condominium; and
10	(2) Shall adopt bylaws or rules to prohibit unit owners,
11	guests, and all other persons from smoking in all:
12	(A) Common elements; and
13	(B) Limited common elements that are covered.
14	For the purposes of this section, the term "covered" means
15	closed in by a roof or overhang and may include areas commonly
16	described as public lobbies, lanais, interior courtyards,
17	patios, and covered walkways."
