### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRIBUSINESS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the local farmers			
2	have difficulty distributing their products to large retail			
3	establishments. The University of Hawaii operates an			
4	agricultural extension service program that assists local			
5	farmers in the best farming practices.			
6	The purpose of this Act is to require the University of			
7	Hawaii to convene a task force to conduct a study on whether an			
8	agribusiness cooperative program should be established.			
9	SECTION 2. (a) The University of Hawaii shall conduct a			
10	study on whether an agribusiness cooperative program should be			
11	established to:			
12	(1) Assist local farmers in increasing the distribution of			
13	products to large retail establishments; and			
14	(2) Develop feed mills located in this State to lower farm			
15	expenses and minimize the carbon impact of			
16	transporting feed imports to local farmers.			
17	The study shall include a proposal on the means by which the			
18	agribusiness cooperative program may be permanently funded			
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1	through private and public funds and a recommendation on the			
2	appropriate state agency or department under which the program			
3	should be established.			
4	(b)	To conduct the study, the University of Hawaii shall		
5	convene an agribusiness cooperative program task force composed			
6	of:			
7	(1)	The chairperson of the board of agriculture, or		
8		chairperson's designee;		
9	(2)	Three representatives of the Hawaii Farmers Union, as		
10		designated by the president of the Hawaii Farmers		
11		Union;		
12	(3)	A professor of agricultural economics at the		
13		University of Hawaii at Hilo, to be designated by the		
14		chancellor of the University of Hawaii at Hilo;		
15	(4)	A representative of the extension agent program of the		
16		University of Hawaii college of tropical agriculture		
17		and human resources, to be designated by the dean of		
18		the University of Hawaii college of tropical		
19		agriculture and human resources;		
20	(5)	The chief executive officer of the Hawaii Food		
21		Industry Association;		

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1	(6)	The president of the Hawaii Farm Bureau Federation, or	
2		the president's designee;	
3	(7)	The president of the Hawaii Cattlemen's Council, Inc.,	
4		or the president's designee; and	
5	(8)	A professor of animal livestock at the University of	
6		Hawaii at Manoa, to be designated by the dean of the	
7		University of Hawaii college of tropical agriculture	
8		and human resources.	
9	(C)	As used in this section:	
10	"Lar	ge retail establishment" means warehouse clubs and	
11	stores, b	ig box retail facilities, and other large supermarkets	
12	that sell	produce, poultry, or meats. In general, large retail	
13	establish	ments range in size from twenty thousand square feet to	
14	two hundr	ed thousand square feet.	
15	"Loc	al farmer" means a farmer whose farm is located in	
16	Hawaii.		
17	SECTION 3. The University of Hawaii shall report findings		
18	and recommendations to the legislature no later than twenty days		
19	prior to	the convening of the regular session of 2012.	

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SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
