A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 431:14G, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

 "§431:14G- Public review and comment. (a) Upon
- 5 receipt of a rate filing requesting a rate change, the
- 6 commissioner, within three business days, shall post the rate
- 7 filing and a plain-language explanation of the rate filing on
- 8 the commissioner's website.
- 9 (b) The rate filing shall be available for public review
- 10 and comment through the commissioner for a period of thirty
- 11 days. An accident and health or sickness insurer under article
- 12 10A, a mutual benefit society under chapter 432, or a health
- 13 maintenance organization under chapter 432D that has submitted a
- 14 rate filing shall respond to comments received during the review
- 15 and comment period. During the public review and comment
- 16 period, the commissioner shall hold a public hearing on the rate
- 17 filing at which the insureds, members, and enrollees of the

- 1 accident and health or sickness insurer, mutual benefit society,
- 2 or health maintenance organization, respectively, may testify.
- 3 (c) The public review and comment period may run
- 4 concurrently with the waiting period described in section
- 5 431:14G-105(g)."
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 7 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 8 begun before its effective date.
- 9 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
