### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 103-8.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$103-8.5 Works of art special fund. (a) There is
- 4 created a works of art special fund, into which shall be
- 5 transferred one per cent of all state fund appropriations for
- $\mathbf{6}$  capital improvements designated for the construction cost
- 7 element; provided that this transfer shall apply only to capital
- $oldsymbol{8}$  improvement appropriations that are designated for the
- 9 construction or renovation of state buildings. The one per cent
- 10 transfer requirement shall not apply to appropriations from the
- 11 passenger facility charge special fund established by section
- 12 261-5.5 and the rental motor vehicle customer facility charge
- 13 special fund established under section 261-5.6.
- 14 (b) The works of art special fund shall be used solely for
- 15 the following purposes:
- 16 (1) Costs related to the acquisition of works of art,
- 17 including any consultant or staff services required to

1		carry out the art in public places and relocatable
2		works of art programs;
3	(2)	Site modifications, display, and interpretive work
4		necessary for the exhibition of works of art;
5	(3)	Upkeep services, including maintenance, repair, and
6		restoration of works of art;
7	(4)	Storing and transporting works of art[+]; and
8	(5)	Costs related to the restoration or renovation of
9		buildings on either the state or federal register of
10		historical buildings.
11	(c)	The one per cent amount, which is included in all
12	capital i	mprovement appropriations, shall be calculated at the
13	time the	appropriation bills are signed into law. The moneys
14	shall be	transferred into the works of art special fund upon
15	availability of moneys from the appropriations. Each agency	
16	receiving capital improvement appropriations shall calculate th	
17	one per cent amount and transfer the moneys into the works of	
18	art special fund.	
19	(d)	The comptroller and the state foundation on culture
20	and the a	rts shall decide on the specific art objects to
21	acquire,	giving first consideration to placing appropriate

pieces of art at the locations of the original appropriation.

- 6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011,
- provided that on June 30, 2016, section 1 of this Act shall be 7
- 8 repealed and section 103-8.5, Hawaii Revised Statues, is
- 9 reenacted in the form in which it read on the day before the
- 10 approval of this Act.
