A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAII STATE DOG APPRECIATION DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that dogs in Hawaii
 deserve to be recognized for their many contributions to the
 people of the State of Hawaii.

While the legislature finds that dogs, which are the most widely owned domesticated animals in Hawaii are appreciated for their patience, unquestioning loyalty and their capacity for love by becoming extended members of Hawaii's families; moreover dogs are known for their unmatched record and spirit of service to our citizens.

The legislature finds that dogs have an impact on the lives 10 11 of our people everyday, serving those with disabilities by 12 providing living assistance as guide dogs, hearing dogs and 13 service dogs and providing protection. Dogs serve soldiers, law 14 enforcement partners, children and elders who are disabled, 15 detect bombs and drugs, pull victims of tragedy from wreckage in 16 situations of disaster, thereby protecting our freedom. Dogs 17 have earned the title of "Man's Best Friend".

The legislature also finds that dogs are utilized in
 various forms of therapy and have been shown to aid in
 increasing recovery for patients suffering from physical,
 emotional, and social conditions.

5 The legislature appreciates the fact that the Americans 6 with Disabilities Act, signed into law in 1990 guarantees people 7 with disabilities the right to be accompanied by a service 8 animal in all areas open to the general public and that laws 9 such as these illustrate and support the importance of dogs in 10 our daily lives.

11 The purpose of this act is to designate August 26th as12 Hawaii State Dog Appreciation Day.

13 SECTION 2. Chapter 8, Hawai'i Revised Statutes, is amended 14 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to 15 read as follows:

16 "<u>\$8-</u> Hawaii State Dog Appreciation Day. August 26th 17 shall be known and designated "Hawaii State Dog Appreciation 18 Day". This day is not and shall not be construed as a state 19 holiday."

20 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
21 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
