BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 291-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

- 11 (2) The side racks of the vehicle are securely attached
 12 and the tailboard or tailgate is securely closed;
- 13 (3) Every-passenger in the bed or load-carrying-area of

- 15 attempt to control unlashed cargo.
- 16 (b) This section shall not apply to persons or
- 17 corporations operating a business or businesses that serve the
