A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SUNSHINE LAW.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that while openness in
2	government continues to be an important principle for Hawaii's
3	people, the requirement that the sunshine law be strictly
4	construed in favor of openness fails to take into account the
5	principle of government efficiency, which is similarly important
6	to Hawaii's people.
7	The purpose of this Act, therefore, is to:
8	(1) Ensure that due consideration is given to the
9 ·	principle of government efficiency when construing the
10	sunshine law; and
11	(2) Establish a reasonableness standard for the
12	construction of the sunshine law's provisions.
13	SECTION 2. Section 92-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	"§92-1 Declaration of policy and intent. In a democracy,
16	the people are vested with the ultimate decision-making power.
17	Governmental agencies exist to aid the people in the formation
18	and conduct of public policy. Opening up [the] governmental

1	processes to public scrutiny and participation is the only
2	viable and reasonable method of protecting the public's
3	interest. Therefore, the legislature declares that it is the
4	policy of this State that the formation and conduct of public
5	policy - the discussions, deliberations, decisions, and action
6	of governmental agencies - shall be conducted [as openly as
7	possible.] openly, efficiently, and economically on behalf of
8	the people. To implement this policy the legislature declares
9	that:
10	(1) It is the intent of this part to protect the people's
11	right to know;
12	(2) The provisions requiring open meetings shall be
13	liberally construed with due regard to the efficient
14	and economical use of government resources; and
15	(3) The provisions providing for exceptions to the open
16	meeting requirements shall be [strictly] reasonably
17	construed against closed meetings."
18	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
19	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
20	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
