A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES AND HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

PART I

2 SECTION 1. According to the executive office on aging, the 3 elderly population in Hawaii is one of the fastest growing in 4 the country. Between 1990 and 2000, the number of persons aged 5 sixty and older increased by nineteen per cent, compared to a 6 nationwide increase of nine per cent. Studies conducted by the 7 executive office on aging and the four county area agencies on 8 aging have indicated that the elderly in Hawaii have a 9 significant need for assistance in various areas and this need 10 is outpacing the ability to provide assistance. Significant 11 issues that arise with elderly people include health status, 12 changes in family structure (caregivers), social security stability for the future, fear of health care burdens (financial 13 14 stability), and changes in public responsibility. Case 15 management and needs assessments of older adults are required to 16 mold programs and services to meet the needs of the elderly 17 community. As Hawaii's culture and values revolve around 18 family, most caregiving of the elderly in Hawaii is provided by HB160 SD2 LRB 11-2993.doc

1 family members, which poses financial hardships for these family 2 members. Financial stability and burden are the main issues for 3 the elderly and their caregivers and families. Long-term care 4 services are expensive and the high cost for services may lead 5 to changes in living arrangements and family households, 6 especially in Hawaii.

7 The kupuna care program was established in 1999 as a 8 collaborative effort by several agencies in Hawaii to address 9 the needs of the elderly population and the issues arising from 10 those needs. The program is home- and community-based, designed 11 to address the increased need for affordable long-term care and 12 the desire to remain in the community. Kupuna care is 13 considered to be an alternative to the traditional long-term 14 care options, which include hospitals, nursing homes, adult 15 residential care homes, adult foster homes, hospice, senior 16 housing, public guardianship, and other programs administered by other state offices. The goal of kupuna care is to give 17 18 Hawaii's elderly population access to affordable and quality 19 home- and community-based services that are client-centered and 20 family-supportive, allowing the elderly to live with 21 independence and dignity. 12	care. According to the state program report for fiscal year			
13	2008 as p	repared by the executive office on aging, 3,277 elders

15	served by case managers, 874 elders used personal care, and 597			
16	elders used the homemaker services. Kupuna care fills an			
17	important gap in assistance for the elderly in Hawaii and cuts			
18	in service would be detrimental to their ability to live with			
19	independence and dignity.			
20	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general			
21	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much			

22 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 and the

This funding shall be in addition to the \$ 4 executive office on aging base budget. 5 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 6 of health for the purposes of this part. 7 PART II 8 SECTION 3. The legislature finds that the national and global economic crisis that began in the second half of 2008 has 9 10 caused significant economic problems in numerous industries in 11 the State, including the airline, cruise ship, tourist, and 12 construction industries. Mass layoffs have been reported by an 13 increasing number of Hawaii businesses statewide, from the 14 agricultural sector to the medical-services sector. Difficult 15 economic times and declining tax revenues have resulted in 16 budget cuts for all state services. 17 The current and impending situation jeopardizes the safety 18 net of basic human services, health, and education needs for 19 Hawaii's residents and families. While all of Hawaii's 20 residents will be affected by the situation, gap group families

21 and families closest to the poverty line will suffer the most.
