BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 432:2-704, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: "(a) Nothing contained in this article shall be so

construed as to affect or apply to:

- (1) Grand or subordinate lodges of societies, orders, or associations now doing business in this State [which] that provide benefits exclusively through local or subordinate lodges;
- 9 (2) Orders, societies, or associations [which] that admit
 10 to membership only persons engaged in one or more
 11 crafts or hazardous occupations, in the same or
 12 similar lines of business, insuring only their own
 13 members and their families, and the ladies' societies
 14 or ladies' auxiliaries to such orders, societies, or
 15 associations;
 - (3) Domestic societies [which] that limit their membership to employees of a particular city or town, designated firm, business house or corporation [which] that
