A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CERTIFICATES OF IDENTIFICATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that it is critical for
 all citizens in Hawaii to obtain state identification. The
 State authorizes the counties to issue state driver's licenses
 in several convenient locations. However, those without state
 driver's licenses must obtain civil identification, which is
 obtained in few locations throughout the State.

7 The purpose of this Act is to authorize the attorney 8 general to work with the counties to allow them to issue civil 9 identifications at the same locations where driver's licenses 10 are issued.

11 SECTION 2. Section 846-21, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
12 amended to read as follows:

13 "§846-21 Authority of attorney general. (a) The attorney
14 general shall carry out this part. In conformity with chapter
15 76, the attorney general may appoint [such] subordinates, at
16 [such] compensation, within the limits of available
17 appropriations therefor, or without compensation, as may be
18 necessary or proper to carry out this part, and, the attorney

2 attorney general's powers and duties as may be necessary for the 3 efficient administration of this part. 4 The attorney general may, in cooperation with the (b) 5 appropriate county agencies, establish a program whereby county employees may issue certificates of identification under this 6 7 part at locations where driver's licenses are issued." 8 SECTION 3. The attorney general shall, in cooperation with the counties, explore options and procedures to allow the 9 10 counties to issue certificates of identification. The attorney 11 general, in consultation with the counties, shall submit a 12 report to the legislature, including findings, recommendations, 13 and any proposed legislation, no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2012. 14 15 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 16 17 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 18 INTRODUCED BY: HMS 2011-1537
