1	SECT	ION 1. Section 84-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	" (b)	The disclosure of financial interest required by this
4	section shall be filed:	
5	(1)	Between January 1 [and May 31 of each year;] and the
6		second Wednesday in January of each year, and an
7		updated disclosure of financial interest shall be
8		filed between May 15 and May 31 of each year;
9	(2)	Within thirty days of one's election or appointment to
10		a state position enumerated in subsection (c); or
11	(3)	Within thirty days of separation from a state position
12		if a prior financial disclosure statement for the
13		position was not filed within the one hundred eighty
14		days preceding the date of separation;
15	provided	that candidates for state elective offices or the
16	constitutional convention shall file the required statements no	
17	later than twenty days prior to the date of the primary election	



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1 for state offices or the election of delegates to the

2 constitutional convention."

3 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
