A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HELMETS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to Part IV to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§286-A Safety helmets; rules. The director shall
5	adopt rules, subject to the requirements of chapter 91,
6	establishing specifications and standards for safety helmets
7	offered for sale, or sold, for use by drivers and passengers of
8	motorcycles, motor scooters, mopeds, and bicycles as the
9	director determines are necessary for the safety of those
10	drivers and passengers. The rules shall include, but are not
11	limited to, the requirements imposed by Federal Motor Vehicle
12	Safety Standard No. 218 (49 C.F.R. Sec. 571.218) and may include
13	compliance with that federal standard by incorporation of its
14	requirements by reference. Each helmet sold or offered for sale
15	for use by drivers and passengers of motorcycles, motor
16	scooters, mopeds, and bicycles, shall be conspicuously labeled
17	in accordance with the federal standard which shall constitute



1	the manufacturer's certification that the helmet conforms to the
2	applicable federal motor vehicle safety standards."
3	SECTION 2. Section 286-81, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4	amended to read as follows:
5	"PART IV. SAFETY EQUIPMENT
6	§286-81 Motorcycle, motor scooter, moped, etc.; protective
7	devices. (a) No person shall:
8	(1) Operate a motorcycle [or] <u>,</u> motor scooter, <u>or moped</u> on
9	any highway in the State unless the person and any
10	passenger the person carries on the motorcycle [or], ,
11	motor scooter, or moped wears:
12	(A) Safety glasses, goggles, or a face shield, in the
13	case of a motorcycle or motor scooter that is not
14	equipped with windscreens or windshields; [and]
15	(B) A safety helmet; and
16	[(B)] <u>(C)</u> Any other protective devices[, other than a
17	safety helmet, required by rules adopted by the
18	director.
19	For the purpose of meeting the requirements of this
20	paragraph, a required device shall meet the
21	specifications and requirements established by rules
22	adopted by the director;

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1	(2) Lease or rent a motorcycle [or], motor scooter, or
2	moped to another person unless the person furnishes:
3	(A) Safety glasses, goggles, or a face shield, in the
4	case of a motorcycle [or], motor scooter, or
5	moped that is not equipped with windscreens or
6	windshields; [and]
7	(B) A safety helmet for the operator and for any
8	passenger the operator carries on the motorcycle,
9	motor scooter, or moped; and
10	[-(B)] (C) Any other protective devices required by the
11	rules adopted by the director for the use of the
12	person or persons intending to operate or ride as
13	a passenger on the motorcycle or motor scooter;
14	provided that any person to whom a motorcycle or
15	motor scooter is leased or rented may furnish for
16	the person's own use the protective devices
17	required by this part.
18	For the purposes of meeting the requirements of this
19	paragraph, a required device shall meet the
20	specifications and requirements established by rules
21	adopted by the director; [or]



1	(3)	Sell or offer for sale for use by a driver or
2		passenger of a motorcycle, motor scooter, or moped,
3		any safety helmet which is not of a type meeting
4		requirements established by the rules adopted by the
5		director; or
6	(4)	Sell or offer for sale or furnish any [safety helmet,]
7		safety glasses, goggles, face shield, windscreen,
8		windshield, or other protective devices represented to
9		meet the requirements of this part unless the device
10		meets the specifications and requirements established
11		by rules adopted by the director.
12	- (d) -	-No person less than eighteen years of age shall
13	operate o :	r-ride as a passenger on a motorcycle or motor scooter
14	on any hig	ghway in the State unless the person wears a safety
15	helmet-see	curely fastened with a chin strap.
16	(c)	-A safety helmet shall not be required for any person
17	who operat	tes or rides as a passenger on a motorcycle or motor
18	scooter;]	provided that the motorcycle or motor scooter:
19	(1)	Has three wheels;
20	(2)	Is powered by an electric motor;
21	(3)	Has a full body enclosed cab; and

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1	(4) Has a-seat belt assembly or a child restraint system
2	for the driver and passenger;
3	and the operator and passenger uses the seat-belt or child
4	restraint system pursuant to sections 291-11.5 and 291-11.6.]
5	(b) For the purposes of this section, "wear a safety
6	helmet" means having a safety helmet meeting the requirements of
7	section 286- on the person's head that is fastened with the
8	helmet straps and that is of a size that fits the person's head
9	securely without excessive lateral or vertical movement.
10	(c) This section does not apply to a person operating, or
11	riding as a passenger in, a fully enclosed three-wheeled motor
12	vehicle that is not less than seven feet in length and not less
13	than four feet in width, and has an unladen weight of 900 pounds
14	or more, if the vehicle meets or exceeds all of the requirements
15	of the Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards, and the rules and
16	regulations adopted by the United States Department of
17	Transportation and the National Highway Traffic Safety
18	Administration, and if the vehicle has a seat belt assembly or a
19	child restraint system for the driver and passenger, and the
20	operator and any passengers use the seat belt or child restraint
21	system pursuant to sections 291-11.5 and 291-11.6."

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SECTION 3. Section 291C-150, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

3 "[§291C-150] Bicycle helmets. (a) No person [under 4 sixteen years of age] shall operate a bicycle upon a street, 5 bikeway, highway, or any other public property unless that 6 person is wearing a properly fitted and fastened bicycle helmet 7 that has been tested by a nationally recognized agency such as 8 the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, the National Safety Council, or the Children's Safety Network, and is 9 designed to fit the user and protect against head trauma. 10 This 11 requirement also applies to a person who rides upon a bicycle while in a restraining seat that is attached to the bicycle or 12 who rides in a trailer towed by the bicycle. 13

(b) A person who provides bicycles for hire shall not rent
a bicycle to any person unless every person [who is under age
sixteen] is wearing a bicycle helmet, as required in subsection
(a), while operating the rented bicycle, occupying a restraining
seat that is attached to the rented bicycle, or riding in a
trailer towed by the rented bicycle.

(c) A violation of this section is punishable by a fine of
not more than \$25. The parent or legal guardian having control
or custody of an unemancipated minor whose conduct violates this



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1	section shall be liable for the amount of the fine imposed
2	pursuant to this section.
3	(d) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the fines
4	collected for a violation of this section shall be paid into the
5	state treasury to the credit of the state general fund."
6	SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
7	and stricken.
8	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
