BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to:		
2	(1)	Authorize a state employing agency to establish a	
3		voluntary unpaid leave program for state employees	
4		from July 1, 2011, to June 30, 2013; and	
5	(2)	Encourage agencies to examine the appropriate use of	
6		voluntary unpaid leave as a means of providing	
7		flexible employment opportunities and improving the	
8		cost-effectiveness of operations.	
9	SECT	ION 2. Any state agency may establish a voluntary	
10	unpaid leave program from July 1, 2011, until June 30, 2013.		
11	Under the voluntary unpaid leave program, an employee, subject		
12	to the approval of the employing agency, may request unpaid		
13	leave for a period of time not to exceed one year.		
14	Participation in the program by employees shall be strictly		
15	voluntary.		
16	SECT	ION 3. Any unpaid leave taken by an employee through

2	(2)	An interruption in the employer's contribution to the
3		Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund;
4	(3)	A decrease in the amount of vacation or sick leave
5		earned by the employee prior to any voluntary unpaid
6		leave;
7	(4)	A decrease in the employee's time in service for
8		purposes of the employee's pension, retirement, and
9 [.]		deferred compensation plans; and
10	(5)	Any change in any right, privilege, or benefit that
11		the employee is entitled to or would have been
12		entitled to by law but for the voluntary unpaid leave;
13	provided	that during a period of voluntary unpaid leave, the
14	employee	shall not continue to accrue vacation and sick leave,
15	nor time	in service for the purposes of the employee's
16	participa	tion in pension, retirement, and deferred compensation
17	plans.	
18	SECT	ION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval
19	and shall	be repealed on June 30, 2013.
