A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SPECIAL NUMBER PLATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 249-9.2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows: 3 "(a) In lieu of the number plates contracted on behalf of 4 the counties by the director of finance of the city and county 5 of Honolulu, the director of finance shall provide for a fee, 6 one set of special number plates upon the receipt of an application together with: 7 8 (1)Specific proof that the applicant was awarded the 9 Purple Heart by the United States Department of 10 Defense for wounds received in military or naval 11 combat against an armed enemy of the United States; Certification that the applicant is a veteran; 12 (2)13 Specific proof that the applicant was serving the (3) 14 United States in the military or as a civilian, on Oahu, or offshore at a distance of not more than three 15 16 miles at the time of the December 7, 1941, attack on 17 Pearl Harbor. The director of finance of the city and county 5 of Honolulu shall provide the "GOLD STAR FAMILY" special number plates described in section 249-9.2(b)(10), Hawaii Revised 6 7 Statutes, not later than October 1, 2011. 8 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
