## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE PARKS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 184, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 "§184-Public meeting; park management contracts. (a) This section shall apply to all requests for proposals issued by 5 6 the department for contracts for the management of a state park 7 or the management of any state parks programs or activities 8 within a state park. 9 (b) The department shall hold a public meeting, prior to 10 the issuance of a request for proposals, for the purpose of 11 obtaining community input on the department's intentions and 12 goals in contracting for the services. The public meeting shall 13 be held at the earliest practicable point in the development of the request for proposals, and in any event, no later than 14 **15** thirty days prior to the issuance of the request for proposals. 16 (c) The department shall provide notice at least ten days 17 prior to the public meeting, and the notice shall be published 18 in a newspaper of general circulation in each county in which HB LRB 11-0204.doc

3	(1) The state park or parks affected by the contract;

9	(5) The time, date, and place of the public meeting where
10	written or oral testimony may be submitted."
