10	(3) A person convicted under this section shall be		
11	required to undergo a counseling program as ordered by the		
12	court."		
13	SECTION 2. Section 711-1100, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
14	amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted		
15	and to read as follows:		
16	""Abusive conduct" means malicious conduct, whether by act		
17	or omission, that a reasonable person would find hostile,
