5	SECTION 2. Section 712-1203, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
6	amended by amending subsection (2) to read as follows:
7	"(2) Promoting prostitution in the second degree is a
8	class [0] <u>B</u> felony."
9	SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
10	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
11	begun before its effective date.
12	SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
14	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on January 7, 2059.
