## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 84, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 1 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to 2 3 read as follows: Nepotism. No legislator or employee shall name 4 "§84or appoint to public office or employment any relative who is 5 the legislator's or employee's father, mother, son, daughter, 6 brother, sister, uncle, aunt, first cousin, nephew, niece, 7 grandparent, grandchild, husband, wife, father-in-law, mother-8 in-law, son-in-law, daughter-in-law, brother-in-law, sister-in-9 law, stepfather, stepmother, stepson, stepdaughter, stepbrother, 10 stepsister, half brother, or half sister." 11 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored. 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 13
