A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INFANT AND TODDLER CHILD CARE CENTERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Pursuant to title 17, chapter 895, Hawaii 2 Administrative Rules, the department of human services licenses 3 infant and toddler child care centers. However, the legislature 4 finds that current laws do not adequately protect parents and 5 their infants and toddlers because no standardized procedure exists for an individual to file a complaint against an infant 6 7 and toddler child care center. In addition, there are no rules 8 that specifically address the filing of a complaint against a 9 center's alleged omissions or wrongful actions. Section 17-895-10 6(a)(17), Hawaii Administrative Rules, only requires an infant 11 and toddler child care center to have written operation policies 12 available for review by parents or guardians. This section 13 requires centers to include a statement on grievance procedures, 14 however, there is no requirement for consistency from facility 15 to facility, and the procedures provided may not be clear, which may make it difficult for a parent or guardian to determine how 16 17 to proceed.

1	The purpose of this Act is to require the department of
2	human services to adopt rules to implement standardized
3	procedures for complaints and grievances, by both clients and
4	employees, against infant and toddler child care centers in the
5	state.
6	SECTION 2. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
7	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
8	and to read as follows:
9	"§346- Infant and toddler child care centers;
10	standardized complaint and grievance procedures; public
11	information. (a) The department shall adopt rules in
12	accordance with chapter 91 to implement a standardized set of
13	procedures to accommodate:
14	(1) Complaints by individuals, including parents or legal
15	guardians of infants and toddlers using the services
16	of an infant and toddler child care center; and
17	(2) Grievances by employees of an infant and toddler child
18	care center,
19	regarding omissions or alleged wrongful actions committed by the
20	infant and toddler child care center.
21	(b) The department may make public information regarding
22	this standardized set of procedures, including any additional
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- 1 relevant information, and may publicize it on the department's
- 2 website."
- 3 SECTION 3. Upon the effective date of the new or amended
- 4 rules adopted pursuant to section 2 of this Act, any grievance
- 5 procedure of an infant and toddler child care center, including
- 6 grievance procedures required by section 17-895-6(a)(17), Hawaii
- 7 Administrative Rules, shall be superceded by the new or amended
- 8 rules and of no force or effect.
- 9 SECTION 4. Section 17-895-6(a)(17), Hawaii Administrative
- 10 Rules, shall be repealed upon the adoption of new or amended
- 11 rules pursuant to section 2 of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 5. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 13 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 14 begun before its effective date.
- 15 SECTION 6. New statutory material is underscored.
- 16 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Infant and Toddler Child Care Centers; Grievance Procedures

Description:

Requires the Department of Human Services to adopt rules to implement a standardized set of procedures accommodating complaints and grievances against infant and toddler child care centers. Allows the department to publicize the procedures, including on its website. Effective July 1, 2050. (HB26 HD1)

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
