RELATING TO THE PROBATION SERVICES FEE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 706-648, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:
3	"(1) The court, when sentencing a defendant to
4	probation[τ] or granting deferral of a plea under section 853-1,
5	shall order the defendant to pay a probation services fee. The
6	amount of the fee shall be as follows:
7	(a) \$150, when the term of probation or period of deferral
8	is for more than one year; or
9	(b) \$75, when the term of probation or period of deferral
10	is for one year or less;
11	provided that no fee shall be ordered when the court determines
12	that the defendant is unable to pay the fee."
13	SECTION 2. Section 853-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
14	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
15	"(b) The proceedings may be deferred upon any of the
16	conditions specified by section 706-624. As a further
17	condition, the court shall impose a compensation fee pursuant to
18	section 351-62.6 and a probation services fee pursuant to

1 section 706-648 upon every defendant who has entered a plea of 2 guilty or nolo contendere to a petty misdemeanor, misdemeanor, 3 or felony; provided that the court shall waive the imposition of a compensation or probation services fee, if it finds that the 4 5 defendant is unable to pay the compensation or probation 6 services fee. The court may defer the proceedings for a period 7 of time as the court shall direct but in no case to exceed the 8 maximum sentence allowable; provided that, if the defendant has 9 entered a plea of guilty or nolo contendere to a petty 10 misdemeanor, the court may defer the proceedings for a period 11 not to exceed one year. The defendant may be subject to bail or 12 recognizance at the court's discretion during the period during 13 which the proceedings are deferred." 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall not apply to any defendant 15 granted a deferred acceptance of guilty or no contest plea before the effective date of this Act. 16 17 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed

18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

19 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on January 7, 2059.
