A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VOG.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. 1 (a) There shall be established within the 2 office of Hawaii state civil defense an inter-agency volcanic activity task force. The task force shall review the effects of 3 4 volcanic activity, particularly the effects and impact of vog, 5 on human health, school children, agriculture, farm and ranch animals, public infrastructure, the visitor industry, and any 6 7 other issue the task force deems necessary. The task force 8 shall develop a plan and make recommendations to the legislature 9 on addressing any issue the task force determines is feasible to 10 address. The task force may adopt resolutions encompassing any 11 issue being reviewed by the task force and may forward these 12 resolutions to any federal, state, or county agency for 13 appropriate action.

14 (b) The inter-agency volcanic activity task force shall 15 meet bi-monthly on Hawaii island at a place and time to be 16 determined by the chair of the task force. Meeting notices 17 shall be posted by the task force as required under chapter 92, 18 Hawaii Revised Statutes, and public testimony at meetings shall HB HMS 2011-1266 HB HMS 2011-1266

4	administr	ative support, including the recording of minutes, to

7	force sha	ll be the vice director of civil defense. The task
8	force sha	ll include the following members or their designee:
9	(1)	Mayor of the County of Hawaii;

11	(3)	The representative of the 5 th representative district;
12	(4)	The senator of the 2 nd senatorial district;
13	(5)	Hawaii County Council members representing lower Puna

16	(7)	Director of Hawaii county department of public works;
17	(8)	East Hawaii chair of the department of education;
18	(9)	Chairperson of the board of agriculture;
19	(10)	Chairperson of the board of land and natural

7	compensation and all necessary expenses, including travel

11	submit a preliminary plan and strategy report to the legislature	
12	no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular	
13	session of 2013.
