Gambling by the use of slot machines and video poker machines shall be legal; provided that the gambling 10 is not visible from the street and is limited to designated 11 12 resort areas located on the island of Oahu as provided by law." 13 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall be as follows: 14 "Shall gambling by the use of slot machines and video poker 15 machines be legal in Hawaii if the gambling is not visible 16
