1	SECT.	ION 1. Section 281-78, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

5	(1)	Public highway, except as permitted in section 291-

7	(2)	Public sidewalk, including any sidewalk within a
8		public housing project as defined in section 356D-1 or

10	(3)	Common area of a public housing project as defined in
11		section 356D-1 or 356D-91[-]; provided that it shall
12		also be a violation of this section to possess, while
13		on any common area of a public housing project, any
14		bottle, can, or other receptacle containing any
15		intoxicating liquor that has been opened, or a seal
16		broken, or the contents of which have been partially
17		removed. For purposes of this paragraph, "common
18		area" means roofs, halls, corridors, lobbies, stairs,

stairways, fire escapes, entrances and [+]exits[+] of the building or buildings, basements, yards, gardens, recreational facilities, parking areas, storage spaces, and other parts of the project normally in common use or other areas designated by the Hawaii public housing authority."

7 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 8 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 9 begun before its effective date.

10 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
