7	shall be	an affirmative defense to any prosecution that the:
8	<u>(a)</u>	Purchaser falsely represented the purchaser's age by
9		producing a driver's license bearing a photograph of
10		the licensee, a state identification card, or similar
11		card purporting to be a valid identification card
12		indicating that the purchaser was eighteen years of
13		age or older;
14	<u>(b)</u>	Appearance of the purchaser was such that an ordinary
15		prudent person would believe the purchaser to be
16		eighteen years of age or older; and
17	<u>(c)</u>	Sale was made in good faith relying upon the
18		indicators of age in paragraphs (a) and (b).

1	(2) Any person who violates this section shall be subject
2	to a fine of not more than \$2,000, imprisonment of not more than
3	ninety days, or both."
4	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
5	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
6	begun before its effective date.
