### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LIFE INSURANCE POLICIES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 431:10-206, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§431:10-206 Application for insurance: consent of 4 insured required. No life insurance or accident and health or 5 sickness insurance contract upon an individual shall be made or 6 effectuated by the individual or any other individual or 7 employer unless at the time of the making of the contract the 8 individual insured, being of competent legal capacity to 9 contract, applies for or consents to the insurance in writing, 10 except in the following cases: 11 (1)A spouse may effectuate such insurance upon the other 12 spouse[+]; and 13 Any person having an insurable interest in the life of (2) a minor, or any person upon whom a minor is dependent 14 for support and maintenance, may effectuate insurance 15

upon the life of or pertaining to the minor.

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This section shall not apply to contracts of group life
 insurance or of group or blanket disability insurance as defined
 in this code."

4 Section 431:10D-202, Hawaii Revised Statutes, SECTION 2. 5 is amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 6 "(a) The lives of a group of individuals may be insured 7 under a policy issued to an employer, or to the trustees of a 8 fund established by an employer, which employer or trustee is 9 deemed the policyholder, insuring employees of the employer for 10 the benefit of persons other than the employer; provided that if 11 the entire cost of the insurance has been borne by the employer 12 and the employer uses the benefits for the purpose of purchasing 13 employer securities distributed to employees from a pension, profit sharing, stock bonus, or employee stock ownership plan 14 15 which has been qualified under [section] Section 401 of the **16** ` Internal Revenue Code, benefits may be made payable to the employer; provided further that the employer: 17

18 (1) Notifies the employee in writing that the employer
19 intends to insure the employee's life and amount for
20 which the employee is to be insured at the time the
21 contract is issued;



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1	(2) Notifies the employee that the employer is the
2	intended beneficiary of the insurance; and
3	(3) Obtains the employee's written consent."
4	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
6	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
