

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1	. Section 708-813, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended to read	d as follows:	
3	"§708-813	Criminal trespass in the first degree. (1) A	
4	person commits	the offense of criminal trespass in the first	
5	degree if:		
6	(a) That	person knowingly enters or remains unlawfully:	
7	(i)	In a dwelling; or	
8	(ii)	In or upon the premises of a hotel or apartment	
9		building;	
10	(b) That	person:	
11	(i)	Knowingly enters or remains unlawfully in or upon	
12		premises that are fenced or enclosed in a manner	
13		designed to exclude intruders; and	
14	(ii)	Is in possession of a firearm, as defined in	
15		section 134-1, at the time of the intrusion; or	
16	(c) That	person enters or remains unlawfully in or upon	
17	the	premises of any public school as defined in	
18	sect	ion 302A-101, or any private school, after

14	(2)	As used in this section:
15	"Housing authorities" means resident managers or managers,	
16	tenant monitors, security guards, or others officially	
17	designated by the Hawaii public housing authority.	
18	"Invited guest" means a person who enters or remains in or	
19	upon the premises of any public housing project in response to	
20	an express or implied invitation by a resident and who is not in	
21	violation of any law or public housing project rule.

1 [-(2)] (3) Criminal trespass in the first degree is a
2 misdemeanor."

3 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
5 begun, before its effective date.

6 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2012.

Report Title: Criminal Trespass; Public Housing Project.

Description:

Broadens criminal trespass in the first degree to include a person who enters or remains unlawfully in or upon the premises of a public housing project after a reasonable request or warning to leave by housing authorities or a police officer. Excludes an invited guest, unless the guest is violating a law or rule.
