A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The director of transportation shall 2 conduct a feasibility study on the construction of an 3 alternative access road to be built mauka of Farrington highway 4 beginning at Lualualei Naval Magazine road that provides access 5 into and out of the leeward coast of Oahu. The study shall 6 include at least the following: 7 (1) A cost-benefit analysis of establishing this mauka 8 alternative access road; 9 (2)Identification and evaluation of desired, intended, 10 and possibly unintended effects of establishing this 11 mauka alternative access road; 12 (3) A timetable for the construction of this mauka 13 alternative access road; (4) Identification and evaluation of any other potential 14 15 alternative access routes into the leeward coast that 16 would be more cost-beneficial than this mauka

11	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general	
12	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$250,000 or so much	
13	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 for a	
14	feasibility study on the construction of an alternative access	
15	road to be built mauka of Farrington highway beginning at	
16	Lualualei Naval Magazine road that provides access into and out	
17	of the leeward coast of Oahu.	
18	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of	

19 transportation for the purposes of this Act.
